Scientific activities and awards

Main fields of scientific activity are treatment of oncologic abdominal and thoracic diseases; minimally invasive treatments of benign bilio-pancreatic diseases; robotic surgery; liver laparoscopic surgery and adhesion syndromes. His scientific contribution is documented by the following:
